Welcome to the Oak Brook Owners Association 3rd Quarter 2025 Newsletter. The Oak Brook Board of Directors continues to work to maintain and improve our neighborhood for safety, appeal, and value.

Assessments Increase

At the October 6th Oak Brook HOA Board of Directors meeting, after budget discussions the board considered and voted on increasing the monthly assessments from \$45/month to \$50/month beginning January 1, 2026. Many of our monthly costs have increased and in order for us to maintain a balanced budget, this increase is warranted. The last increase to our current \$45/month assessment occurred in 2012. For those who write checks or do on-line bill pay, only the amount needs to be modified for your January 2026 payment. Reminder From Fern Bluff MUD of Winter Water Averaging

Winter waste water averaging begins on November 15th and ends on February 14th. Winter months are used to calculate the sewer averaging because historically customers use less water this time of year. To

save money on your sewer bill for the next year, the district recommends that automatic irrigation systems be turned off during the winter season as plants and grass are in their dormant stage.
